- License Fee - \$52.00 (** after July 4, 2013 – current fee is \$50.00*)
- Copy of State Fireworks License
- Certificate of Insurance
- Letter of approval from property owner where tent will be placed
- Missouri Retail Tax ID Number
 - *Non Profit groups must submit a Sales Tax Exemption Letter*
- Certificate of No Tax Due from the State of Missouri (must be dated within 90 days)
 - *This does not apply to Non Profit groups*

Fireworks can be sold within the City Limits on July 1, 2, 3 and 4 of each year. The Fireworks Ordinance is attached to this checklist; please make sure it is reviewed so that all requirements are complied with. The Pleasant Hill Fire Protection District will do walk thru inspections for safety requirements.

ORDINANCE NO. 1665

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SALE AND USE OF FIREWORKS INCLUDING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF**

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council of the City of Pleasant Hill that there is a need to address the sale and use of fireworks within the city limits of the City of Pleasant Hill.

Whereas, the Council desires to change certain provisions of the existing fireworks ordinance.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLEASANT HILL, AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 15-10, relating to the sale and use of fireworks is hereby repealed and in lieu of a new Section 34-37 is hereby enacted:

Section 34-37, Sale use and display of fireworks restricted.

From and after the effective date hereof, and subject to all provisions hereof, permits to sell fireworks shall be issued to all applicants requesting same by June 1 of each year. For the calendar year 2009, the cost of said permits shall be \$25.00, for each year thereafter, the costs of permits shall be \$50.00. (CHANGED WITH THE ADOPTION OF THE FEE SCHEDULE, APRIL 1, 2013)

Fireworks can only be sold on July 1, 2, 3, and 4 of each year. Use of fireworks, shooting or discharge within the city limits shall be allowed only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m., on July 1, 2, and 3 of each year, and from 8:00 a.m. until midnight on July 4th of each year. At no time shall bottle rockets be sold, possessed or discharged within the city limits.

Every vendor or licensee for the sale of fireworks is required to have an adequate fire extinguisher consisting at a minimum: 1 - 5 lb multipurpose fire extinguisher and one air pressurized water extinguisher, which shall be provided and kept in close proximity to the stock of fireworks in each building or stand where fireworks are sold and/or stored.

Any building or stand where fireworks are sold and/or stored must be in an area zoned for Commercial use (C-1).

The use or discharge of any fireworks is prohibited at the City Lake.

It is unlawful to attempt to sell or to sell at retail any fireworks to children under the age of fourteen (14) years except when such child is in the presence of a parent or guardian.

It is unlawful for any person under the age of sixteen (16)

to sell fireworks or work in a facility where fireworks are stored, sold or offered for sale unless supervised by an adult.

It is unlawful to discharge fireworks within one hundred (100) feet of a structure where fireworks are stored, sold, or offered for sale.

No person shall ignite or discharge any permissible articles of fireworks within or throw the same from a motor vehicle, nor shall any person place or throw any ignited article of fireworks into or at a motor vehicle or at or near any person or group of people.

No person shall ignite or discharge fireworks within three hundred (300) feet of any gasoline pump, gasoline filling station or any non-permanent structure where fireworks are stored, sold or offered for sale.

It shall be unlawful to expose fireworks to direct sunlight through glass to the merchandise displayed, except where the fireworks are in the original package. All fireworks which the public may examine shall be kept for sale in original packages, except where an attendant is on duty at all times where fireworks are offered for sale. Fireworks shall be kept in showcases out of the reach of the public when an attendant is not on duty. One or more signs reading, "FIREWORKS-NO SMOKING" shall be displayed at all places where fireworks are stored or sold in letters not less than four inches in height.

The council, by special proclamation, shall have the power to allow the shooting or discharge at other times and specific locations, as the council may deem appropriate.

Any person or entity found in violation of this ordinance shall be punished according to the terms in Section 1-11
