

On Sunday, 7-20-08, during the early morning, a resident at 7969 Lime Street, a residential apartment complex in Fontana, California, looking through a trash dumpster for recyclable materials located a deceased infant male concealed within a nylon back pack. The infant appeared to be a newborn and still had the umbilical cord attached. The Fontana Police Department is actively conducting an investigation but have few leads regarding who may be responsible for this crime.

A very similar incident occurred approximately one year ago directly across from this location. A newborn infant male was located in a field contained within a plastic container. The Fontana Police Department is still actively working this case but unfortunately also have few leads. It is unknown at this time if these incidents are somehow related.

The City of Fontana is currently offering a 5,000 dollar reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the responsible person(s). The California Safe Haven law currently allows a person to turn over a newborn child to law enforcement (police), fire department, churches or medical facilities (hospitals) with no questions asked or risk of prosecution. The law was designed to help protect innocent lives and prevent this type of incident. Information can be reported or provided anonymously.
