Opening:

The regular meeting of the Pleasant Hill Board was called to order at 7:00pm on Tuesday, January 8, 2019 in the Council Chambers at the Pleasant Hill City Hall by Park Board President, Auggie Augspurg.

Present:

Board members in attendance Auggie Augsborg, Andy Bailey, Linda Ewing, Nancy Baker, Stephani Bordner, Mark Crain, Jay English, and David Whitaker. Also in attendance were Tria Cartner, Justin Wieberg, Nick Althausen, and John Hamilton.

Consent Agenda:

Whitaker made the motion to accept the consent agenda. Bailey seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Regular Agenda:

1. ***Old and New Business***
 - a. New Park Board Member - Jay English
 - b. Update: Mural Park
 - * Piers in, brush has been cleared
 - *Preparing to setup a meeting with Goppert Foundation for additional funding
 - c. Update: MoPac Singletrack
 - *Andy Bailey presented new bike trail section, asking for approval to continue trails on the west side of the City Lake.
 - *Needing \$13,000 to continue trail. Bike Stop is interested in doing a demo event to raise funds, Power Plant offered \$3000 when the project began, may request that money now. Power Plant is not asking for anything in return.
 - *Steve Bush donated original trail kiosk, wants to continue to help.
 - *Continuation of trail APPROVED. Stephani made the motion to approve. Mark seconded and it passed unanimously.
 - *Sub-committee for trail events formed: Andy Bailey, Linda Ewing, Tria Cartner.
 - *Linda will communicate with Bike Stop (Renee Thierry) and Dave's Bike Shop in Raymore about organized and regular group rides on the MoPac Singletrack and Rock Island Trails, Bike 101 repair classes, Parent Night Out rides for kids, LadyDudes, etc.
 - *Bike Event (subcommittee) to discuss a Ride the Rock event riding from Windsor to Pleasant Hill (see Ride the Rock event from Pleasant Hill to Windsor info).
 - d. Update: Park Signage
 - *35mph signage \$63.15/sign, \$100.00/post = \$5220.80/32signs, 32 posts. Posts are 4 sided galvanized, grey. May be able to get cheaper, but this is the cost for now. One sign by Roosters Bar (TL) and one in front of Dinges (TR). Requesting

in next budget cycle. Should be on Priority List. Labor done by public works and maintenance.

*Ask MoDot about QR codes on signs.

*QR codes on Mural eventually to tell the story of Pleasant Hill.

Director's Report February 12, 2019

Administration

Mural Park - In the process of searching for funding to build the frame.

MOPAC Phase 3 - The bidding will be advertised starting Wednesday, February 13th for the next 3 weeks.

Aquatics

Staff - We are currently accepting applications for lifeguards.

Maintenance:

Staff - We are currently accepting applications for seasonal maintenance.

Vehicles & Equipment - In the process of winter maintenance to be prepared for Spring.

Yuille Field - Backstop and dugouts will be replaced as soon as the ground dries out a bit.

Recreation:

Concessions Staff: We are currently accepting applications for a Concessions Coordinator and seasonal concessions workers.

Tiny Tots Basketball - We have 38 enrolled.

Youth Basketball - Games started on January 26th.

Youth Volleyball: Spring Session - Registration deadlines are: February 24th (early), March 3rd (regular), and March 10th (late).

Adult Mens Basketball - Session 1 games have been delayed several weeks due to weather. Session 2 will have a delayed start but will hopefully get it in before school is out for the year.

Older Adult Programs - BINGO is scheduled for the first and third Thursday of every month at First Christian Church from 10am-11am. Lunch for \$3 is served afterwards.
