## Pleasant Hill Park Board Regular Meeting Minutes Tuesday, June 11, 2019 Pleasant Hill City Hall

#### Opening:

The regular meeting of the Pleasant Hill Board was called to order at 7:00pm on Tuesday, June 11, 2019 in the Council Chambers at the Pleasant Hill City Hall by Park Board President Auggie Augspurg.

#### Present:

Board members in attendance Auggie Augsburg, Andy Bailey, Linda Ewing, Nancy Baker, Stephani Bordner, Jay English, Heather Shore, and David Whitaker. Also in attendance were Justin Wieberg, Tria Cartner, Nick Althauser, and Landon Fatino.

#### Consent Agenda:

Bailey made a motion to accept the consent agenda. Shore seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

#### Regular Agenda:

#### 1. Old and New Business

- a. Student Park Board Representative Landon Fatino (N)
  - -Made introduction to Park Board Members.
- b. Update: City Lake Trails Andy Bailey (O)
  - -Trail Fest postponed to July 14.
  - -We did not win the People for Bikes grant.
  - -Still enough \$ for some crossings.
  - -Trails are finally rideable!
  - -Trail volunteers put in 9 tons of rock to help with erosion from precipitation.
  - -Weedeating all trail sections in progress.
  - -Should we start MoPac Monday's for group rides/runs? Maybe start in July?
  - -Rocks at sports complex to be used for trail obstacles on the SW section of trail. We need about 30 big rocks. Can city bring those to the trail during the cold season?
- c. Update: Community Garden (O)
  - -We started with 7 families, now there are 18 families helping.
  - -Brendan Grego was a huge help and will be one of the Community Garden Student Representatives.
  - -Tool shed was purchased from the high school.
  - -There are a variety of vegetables planted. The raised garden beds are all herbs.
  - -Sponsored ice cream social June 24 @ 7:00pm.
  - -Two acts of vandalism to soaker hoses-seems like they were cut with knives.
- d. Update: Sub-Committees
  - i. Pool Operations
    - -SWOT Analysis: Stefani spoke with Kaitlyn-pool staff had many positive things to say about Justin and Nick and what they have done to make improvements.
    - -Shortage of guards across the metro so the amount of guards we have in PH is great.
    - -Sprinkler is fixed.
  - ii. Trail Subcommittee
    - -Flyer went out in the water bill to share what amenities the PH trail systems offer.

- -The porta potties for the original Trail Fest were stopped (due to weather cancellation) before having to pay for them.
- -Andy reported some brush dumped at city lake by a kid who says he was dropping it off for a future bonfire.
- e. Update: Reggie Rays Lot Park Name (O)
  - -Justin put a poll on facebook to vote on a park name from the names the 4th graders came up
  - with. PBM voted.
  - -Bailey made a motion to name the park "Wyoming Street Crossing." Bordner seconded the motion and it was unanimous.
- f. Update: Big Creek BBQ Competition (O)
  - -Justin spoke to Hay's-nobody to take over the competition yet, Hays is continuing to look. Tabled for now.
- g. Discussion: Pickleball (N)
  - -Citizens have reached out to see about getting Pickleball lines on the tennis court at the City Park.
  - -Can we have a league in PH?
  - -Indoor Pickleball in Memorial Building also when the weather is not cooperative?
  - -Bordner made a motion to approve looking into pickleball further. Whitaker seconded the motion and it was unanimous.
- h. Discussion: Summer Events (N)
  - -Pool July 4-Free Admission 12pm-8pm for fireworks
  - -Cass County Fair
  - -5k Suicide Prevention
  - -End of Summer City Gathering?
  - -Floating for Freedom for parents after kids go to school (at pool).
  - -HOSA Trail Race-September 8 at 8:00am. City has a timing system and online registration. Landon will update as HOSA irons out details.
- 2. Comments from the Board Members and Public:
  - -Jay commented on the rebar around fire pits at the City Lake needing addressed. There is a citizen wanting to clean up City Lake restroom and some of the campgrounds, possibly donating materials.
