CURRENT CITY PROJECTS

The City's annual budget allocates funding for operations, major purchases, and public improvement projects. Learn more about projects that are currently underway.

City Lake Dam: In 2018, city staff noted a leak at the dam on the south side of the City Lake which is located at 16104 S Lake Road. The site of the leak was not deemed detrimental to the lake yet, but further investigation was recommended. Conceptual engineering was completed in 2019, providing three options for repair. The City is currently in the process of soliciting an engineering firm to complete a geotechnical investigation and engineering services. The results of the geotechnical investigation will help inform the City's next steps and/or preferred option for repair. A firm is expected to be selected on September 1st. Funding for this work is provided through the Capital Improvement Sales Tax.

Excavator: The Public Works Department received a new excavator this summer. This will be a replacement of an older excavator. The excavator was purchased with American Rescue Plan Act Funds.

Memorial Building Stair Replacement: The existing stairs at the Memorial Building (212 Cedar St.) have a deteriorating and crumbling surface and are a safety hazard to those utilizing the building. The City is currently seeking proposals for individuals or firms to replace the north stairs and sidewalk. A contractor should be selected on September 8th with work completed in October of 2022.

Sale of Property: The City of Pleasant Hill is accepting proposals for developments in vacant land currently owned by the City. The properties are in the general area of 111 Boardman Rd, corner of Cedar St. and Lake St, and 315 Webster St.

PROJECT NIGHT EYES

The Pleasant Hill Police Department initiated a new program August 1st called Project Night Eyes. This is a proactive approach to ensure the security of our town's businesses.

Officers on overnight patrol will visit a few closed businesses each night to verify doors and windows are locked. If an officer notices something is wrong, they will notify the owner. If not, they will leave a card stating they checked the business and the time of visit. Police Chief Wright plans to keep the program going indefinitely.

"We want to let the bad guys know we are watching," said police Chief Tommy Wright.
