Help us, help you! See the tips below for what is and what is not recyclable.



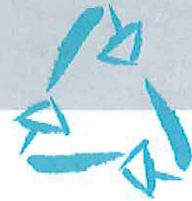
Remember that plastic bags, plastic sacks, and garbage bags cannot be included in recycling. Please place loose recyclables only.

Waste haulers may begin rejecting contaminated loads.

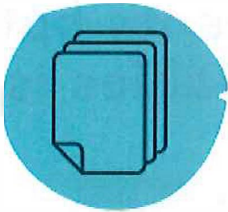
